



GAA Injury Benefit Fund



The GAA Injury Benefit Fund is in place to cover benefits which cannot be claimed elsewhere

In order to make a claim through the GAA Player Injury Fund

- **The player must be fully registered**
- **Injury must have occurred during official training or match**

In the event of a player suffering an injury it is essential that it is reported within **60 days of the date of the injury**

Claims Process

You will then be issued with a Claim Number and an email outlining what information is missing from the claim. Once you have a claim number the other information can follow in time, i.e. medical receipts and stamp from medical centre attended etc.

You can only claim for costs that are not covered by your own Health Insurance Company. A Statement of Account will need to be produced from your insurance company to confirm that the costs were or were not recoverable.

All these forms (and in some cases a referee's report which can be requested from the county board) are forwarded on to DWF to complete the procedure.

Once payment has been approved, notice will be sent to the club confirming the amount to be paid. Payment will be sent to club account and a cheque will be issued to the claimant. This amount will be less the €100 excess.

- Medical – up to a maximum amount of €5200 per claim
- Dental – up to a maximum amount of €5200 per claim
- Loss of Wages – weeks 2 – 26 – covered up to a maximum of €300 per week
- Supplementary Hospital Benefit – 15 days continued hospitalization, but benefit will only be considered where the claimant is in hospital for an initial 10 consecutive days

The only physiotherapy \ treatments covered are those that take place after a surgical procedure. In the absence of surgery, there is no cover for physiotherapy \ treatments

The Fund works on a receipted basis and all treatment must be paid for in full and the receipts sent in for reimbursement
